



Triton Shim Set

Background

Firstly, it's important to note that our shim set is optional. It in no way improves performance. So why did we make shims then? Well, some foilers prefer a more horizontal foiling platform than others like myself. We initially designed the T1 for Rudy and me. And I like to have a little angle to my foilboard when riding in waves. And so, we designed it this way.

Not everybody likes my riding preference so we designed some shims when we released our mast. You now have the option to ride the T1 monowing flatter than my personal preference and that's OK.

Each set will come with two shims that provide roughly 1 and 2 degrees of angle adjustment to your T1.

Cautions:

1. Don't use the shims with non-Triton masts. We have a generic shim for other masts.
2. Ensure your baseplate bolts are long enough. An M8 bolt needs 1.2cm of thread engagement to reach maximum hold. If your bolt has less, invest in longer bolts.
3. Use one shim only. They are not meant to be "doubled up"
