



MANUAL

Thank you for purchasing Triton's X-1 wing monofoil, our dedicated winging foil set. We think you are going to enjoy exploring the fantastic talents of the X-1. Before you try the X-1 for the first time, we wanted to share with you some simple rider tips based on our extensive testing of the X-1 in a variety of conditions.

For your first few sessions on the X-1, we recommend you ride it at wind speeds in the range of 14 to 17kts with a decent hand wing size. Foiling with power will help you quickly get an idea of the X-1's performance envelope in all its dimensions (e.g., tacking, gybing, carving, gliding, pumping, etc.). For your first time in the water with the X-1, we recommend you move the mast all the way forward in the mast track. Your back foot should be positioned on top of the mast to start.

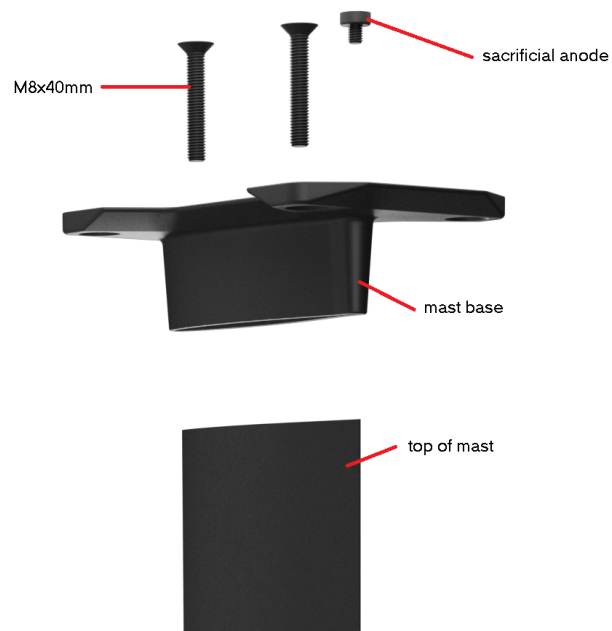
CARE

A few minutes of attention will ensure a lifetime of enjoyment. Please rinse your foil set in fresh water after each use. Use Tefgel on all your screws. Check all screws before every use. Disassemble your foil set periodically and clean it. Always inspect your foil set for wear and/or corrosion. The sacrificial anodes are meant to corrode over time and are replaceable.

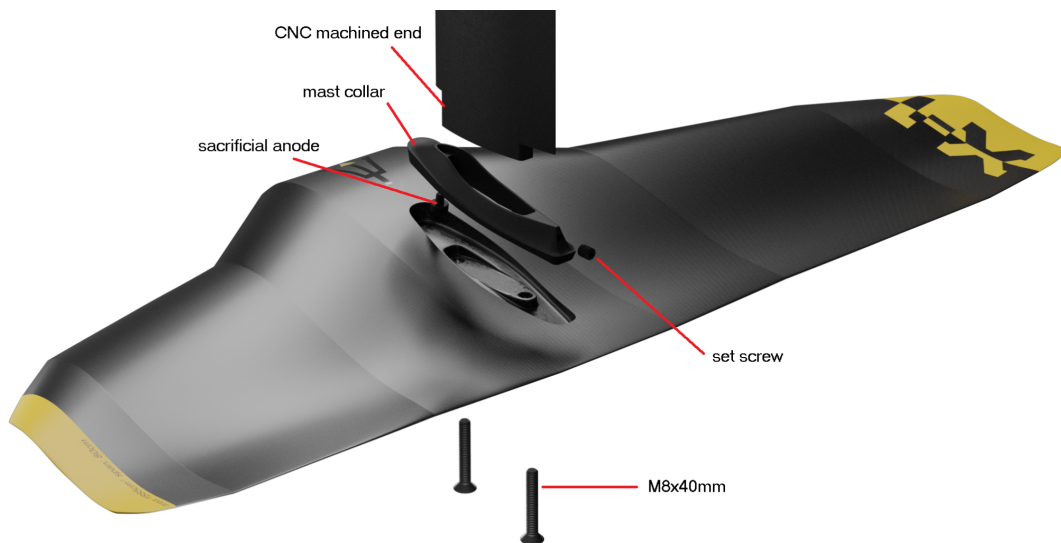
ASSEMBLY



Install the base onto the flat-sided (non-machined) mast end with 2 M8 x 40mm screws.



Slip the mast collar onto the machined end of the mast and tighten the Allen set screw. Do not over-tighten the set screw:



Set the collar into the wing and tighten two M8 x 40mm screws. Do not use shorter M8 screws. Use Tefgel. Check all screws before every use.
